Alumni & Volunteer Engagement Committee

Mission: Assures that LSI's alumni are fully engaged in the organization and their needs are being met while at the same time seeking other community volunteer involvement in the organization's programs and events.

Responsibilities:

- Makes sure that LSI is addressing the needs of the Alumni and keeping their level of satisfaction high in the program
- Works with the Executive Director and Board of Advisors to help staff all committees
- Responsible for insuring that all Committees are coordinating all events communications with the interest of the Alumni in mind
